

# **USE OF COURTS**

## **COURTS 1 & 2 (POLYMERIC).**

**These courts are unsupervised.**

**Do not use them in icy conditions or when under snow.**

**A degree of care needs to be exercised if you choose to play on them after dewfall or rainfall as they can be slippery.**

**Please note that the surface grip will differ in different areas whilst the court is drying out.**

**Proper tennis shoes with a good grip must be worn at all times. Do not wear other types of footwear as avoidable injury may thereby be caused (they do not grip the surface as well). Non-tennis footwear is also liable to damage the surface.**

**The club will not accept liability if members or guests choose to play in unsafe conditions.**

## **COURTS 3 & 4 (ARTIFICIAL CLAY).**

**These courts are unsupervised.**

**Do not use them if under snow or if there is silt on the surface.**

**Areas of grey silt can appear after heavy rain and needs to be cleared away with a brush before commencing to play to ensure the area is not slippery. The addition of some more sand (which can be picked up from the area where the mats are left) may help improve the surface**

**In very dry conditions the courts need to be watered to establish a secure footing. There is a hose for that purpose on court 3 which can be also be used on court 4. Please put back in place after use.**

**Proper tennis shoes with a good grip must be worn at all times. Do not wear other types of footwear as avoidable injury may thereby be caused (they do not grip the surface as well). Non-tennis footwear is also liable to damage the surface.**
